The Battle of Trafalgar (21 October 1805) was a naval engagement fought by the British Royal Navy against the combined fleets of the French Navy and Spanish Navy, during the War of the Third Coalition (August–December 1805) of the Napoleonic Wars (1803–1815).

The battle was the most decisive naval victory of the war. Twenty-seven British ships of the line led by Admiral Lord Nelson aboard HMS Victory defeated thirty-three French and Spanish ships of the line under French Admiral Pierre-Charles Villeneuve off the south-west coast of Spain, just west of Cape Trafalgar. The Franco-Spanish fleet lost twenty-two ships, without a single British vessel being lost.

Located one exit South of the Philadelphia International Airport off of interstate I-95,

From North: Take Blue Route to I-95 North - Take exit 9A (Route 420, Essington)

From Phila: Take Route I-95 South from city, go by airport to exit 9A (Route 420, Essington)

Take 420 South to Dead End, Turn right, club on left just past the Lagoon and Gov. Printz Park
