. 11.30 a.m. Honor-Guard Ceremony, Wreath-Laying and Religious Service at the Cross of Sacrifice and Tomb of the Unknown British Soldier at Northwood Cemetery, 1501 Haines St, Philadelphia (just off the top of North Broad St; also borders on Cheltenham Avenue) - in honor of the Treaty of Versailles - 1919
